- Setting out, levelling and surveying the site and reconciling tender submissions
- Checking plans, drawings, and quantities for accuracy of calculations
- Ensuring that all materials used, and work performed are in accordance with the specifications
- Overseeing the selection and requisition of materials
- Agreeing a price for materials and making cost-effective solutions and proposals for the intended project, value engineering as necessary and possible
- Managing, monitoring, and interpreting the contract design documents supplied by the client or architect
- Liaising with any consultants, subcontractors, supervisors, planners, quantity surveyors and the general workforce involved in the project
- Liaising with the local authority (where appropriate to the project) to ensure compliance with local construction regulations and by-laws
- Communicating with clients and their representatives (architects,

engineers, and surveyors)

- Attending regular meetings to keep clients/representatives informed of progress
  - Carrying out day-to-day management of the site, including supervising and monitoring the site labour force and the work of any subcontractors
  - Planning the work and organising required plant and site facilities in order to meet agreed deadlines
  - Overseeing quality control and health and safety matters on site
  - Preparing reports as required
  - Keeping central Management updated daily on general progress of project completion
  - Resolving any unexpected technical difficulties and other problems that may arise
  - Overseeing site operations and assisting with site paperwork
  - Managing and overseeing all engineering functions and assisting in all contracts as required
  - Working in conjunction with Safety Cert Health and Safety System
  - Site setting out taking measures and creating Asbuilt drawings
  - Helping to negotiate final accounts with measurement records
  - Assisting with Tendering Pre-Quals
  - Overseeing and carrying out risk analysis
